Christian Catholics need to be authentic witnesses of Jesus Christ.

To be authentic witnesses, we need to be AUTHENTIC DISCIPLES, FOLLOWERS of Jesus Christ.

To be disciples / followers of Jesus Christ WE MUST IMITATE Jesus Christ, we must adopt HIS ATTITUDES and HIS MIND (see St. Paul's letter to the Philippians ch.2:5-8).

This is NOT AN OPTION, it is a COMMAND from Jesus himself:

"I give you a NEW COMMANDMENT, LOVE ONE ANOTHER... BY THIS EVERYONE WILL KNOW THAT YOU ARE MY DISCIPLES, IF YOU HAVE LOVE FOR ONE ANOTHER." (John 13:34-35).

The pagan Roman Empire in the first centuries was converted by the great number of Christians who gave witness to the commandment of LOVE, and were ready to die for it.

"Martyr" was the Greek term for witness, from which came the term martyrs.

We may not be called to "red martyrdom" (to give our blood for Christ), but we may be called to "white martyrdom", which means giving witness by the way we live our life, and by patiently putting up with opposition, ridicule and subtle persecution.
