THE TRUTH is that Mass is NOT A SHOW with spectators sitting passively on the pews. One of the reasons behind the absence of Catholics at Mass has been poor catechesis, lack of proper religious formation.

IT IS NEVER TOO LATE to learn that Mass is the SAME SACRIFICE of JESUS on Calvary which is being REPRESENTED on the altar.

IT IS NOT TOO LATE to come to know that the same sacrifice is being offered to God the Father by Jesus for the people of our times.

As the priest stands in the person of Christ on the altar, Jesus repeats for us today to the Father: "FORGIVE THEM, THEY KNOW NOT WHAT THEY DO!"

We reap the benefits of his blood poured out, so that we are FORGIVEN of our sins, and CLEANSED and PURIFIED!

This is why after Mass, we go home CLEAN, and we are NEW persons, and we can say that WE ARE BORN AGAIN!
